Internships (10 units)

Course Waived	When?	Requirements to Waive Course
ESEC 555	After 2 quarters	Successful completion of in all Noyce activities.
ESEC 556	After 3 quarters	Successful completion of all Noyce activities. Data collection, lesson planning for 5 students (see syllabus for details). Prepares for TPA3 test.
ESEC 570A	After 6 quarters	Supervised teaching in Noyce or internship

Student Teaching (6 units)

Course Waived	When?	Requirements to Waive Course
ESEC 550A	After 3 quarters of Noyce	Successful completion of all Noyce activities. Portfolio preparation for supervision – see table of contents
ESEC 550B	After 6 quarters of Noyce	Successful completion of supervised teaching (approved by resident teacher and CSUSB supervisor). See handbook for details.

When you start Noyce	Begin compiling your portfolio – see handbook for table of contents
2 months before you start your first credential course	See Dr. Aitcheson to set a (possibly partial) program plan. After the plan is made, enroll in courses.
In the quarter before applying to the credential program	Attend a Single Subject Program Orientation meetings. Dates available through the Single Subject office or Dr. Saenz.
In the last quarter of your BA/BS/BATT program.	Apply to the credential program. Even if your courses are not complete, please submit the rest of your application.
